**TEMPORARY  
DISORDERLY CONDUCT  
RESTRAINING ORDER**

To the above-named Respondent:

A Petition for a Disorderly conduct Restraining Order has been filed in District Court alleging that you have engaged in disorderly conduct. "Disorderly conduct" means intrusive or unwanted acts, words, or gestures that are intended to adversely affect the safety, security, or privacy of another person. Disorderly conduct does not include constitutionally protected activity.

On the basis of the Petition in this case, the Court concludes there are reasonable grounds to believe the Respondent has engaged in disorderly conduct.

You violate this order if you:

1. Engage in any disorderly conduct toward Petitioner.
2. Have any contact with Petitioner except through an attorney.

**You shall appear on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 200\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ (a.m.)(p.m.)** and show cause why this temporary order should not be extended for a period of up to two years. **The hearing will be held in the Morton County Courthouse, 210 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue NW, Mandan, North Dakota.** If you fail to appear at the hearing, this temporary order may be extended and if you are charged with violating a restraining order, it is no defense that you were not present at the hearing. This order shall be effective until the hearing scheduled above or 30 days from the date of this order.

**Violation of this order is punishable by up to one year in jail and a fine of up to \$1,000. Any peace officer may arrest you with or without a warrant and take you into custody if the peace officer has probable cause to believe you have violated this order.**
